

Access to and destruction of Special Education Records

The special education department at Brazos River Charter School observes federal and state laws, state regulations and local policies pertaining to the confidentiality of student records. Parents (or an eligible student 18 years or older) may inspect and review records at any time. School officials with a legitimate educational interest have access to the student records. The parents of a student with a disability must give written consent before a student's records can be seen by someone not involved in the student's education.

Special education eligibility and educational records are maintained for seven (7) years following the date of the last recorded action for each student served by the special education department. At the end of the seven (7) years those records will be destroyed. We will be destroying our records from the 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 school years.
